I. Introduction: A Christian Atheist is someone who believes in God but lives as if HE doesn't exist.

II. When You Believe In God But Not In Prayer!

- A. Some Christian Atheists create long list of reasons not to pray.
1. Feeling were not good at it.
 2. Not knowing what to say.
 3. Being bored when we do pray.
 4. Not wanting to bother God with our small requests.
 5. Not thinking our prayers can actually make a difference.
- B. What about the Prayers that seem to go unanswered?
1. Give thought to your relationships with other people (Mark 11:24-25).
 2. Give thought to your motives (Jam. 4:3).
 3. Give thought to the way you live (Jam. 5:16).
 4. Give thought to God's Will (I Jn. 5:14-15).
 5. Give thought to your faith (Jam. 1:6-7).

III. When You Believe In God BUT Don't Really Know Him!

- A. There are different levels of knowing God.
1. Some know God by reputation.
 2. Some know God from memory.
 3. Some know God intimately.
- B. Believing in God is not Enough. (Jam. 2:19)
1. We know God when we live to keep His commands (I Jn. 2:3-4).
 2. We know God when we give Him our heart (Mt. 15:8).

IV. When You Believe In God BUT Don't Think You Can Change.

- A. Many of us are mastered by things that aren't God's best for us.
- B. God can help you Change.
1. We must can the excuses (Phil. 4:13).
 2. We must cut the ties (I Cor. 15:33).
 3. We must surrender to God's Power (Mk. 10:27).

V. Conclusion: It's time we shed our hypocrisy and live a life that truly brings glory to God!
